Engineering Professional Development - University of Iowa ...

An internship is a temporary, hands-on learning opportunity that provides meaningful, career-related experience extending a student's education beyond the classroom. At ISU, internships can be paid or unpaid, for credit or not for credit, and for career-related experience at ISU or at an external (non-ISU) employer.

Experiential Learning - Internships, Cooperative Education ...

Parallel Co-ops: Experiential education experiences that meet the work time requirements of Cooperative Education. A student must be enrolled as a half-time student (6 to 9 credits) and be employed in an engineering related work experience that encompasses at least 20 hours per week.

Hire Intern and Co-op Students - Iowa State University ...
