Naturalization is the process by which an alien becomes an American citizen. It is a voluntary act; naturalization is not required. Prior to September 27, 1906, any "court of record" (municipal, county, state, or Federal) could grant United States citizenship. Often petitioners went to the court most geographically convenient for them.

In order to apply for British naturalisation, you must pay the British naturalisation fees and costs in 2020. If you are over 18 years of age, to apply for Naturalisation from inside the UK, it costs £1,330 plus an additional £19.20 to have your biometric information (fingerprints and a photographs) taken.

Form AN Guide The most common route for applying for British Citizenship is naturalisation. To be naturalised as a British citizen, you'll need to apply to the Home Office using Form AN. The AN Form covers most adults who are citizens of another country applying to become a British citizen.

The naturalisation certificate is issued to an individual as evidence that they have been granted British citizenship. Naturalisation certificates can be used to apply for a British passport (original form only is accepted), and for general identification purposes. Strict rules apply however in order for the certificate to be acceptable.

Immediately prior to the naturalisation application, you have a valid residence permit. This is a permanent residence permit or a temporary residence permit with a non-temporary purpose of stay. The residence permit is still valid at the time of the naturalisation ceremony. Do you have the nationality of an EU/EEA country or Switzerland?

According to the rules specified on the naturalisation form, the referees have to declare that they have known the applicant personally for three years and if they intentionally give false information or hide any factual information, they can be subject to a fine of £5000 or imprisonment of 3 months or both.

Once a citizenship application has been approved, for example talking about naturalisation as a British citizen, you'll get an approval letter and you'll be invited to take an oath at your local council, and at this oath ceremony you'll be presented with a certificate of British citizenship and from that day onwards you're a British citizen and that point in time concludes your naturalisation process.
