You'll need to know this to play scales on the uke: to raise a note by a half step you go up one fret on the uke, to raise a note by a full step you go up two frets. Now, there are many ways to play a scale on the ukulele. You can play all of the notes on one string, going up one fret or two frets as appropriate for each note.
