### **Protected Areas in Switzerland**

The oldest protected areas are some of the 41 federal hunting reserves in the alpine areas. These were inaugurated in 1876 in order to prevent excessive depletion of wildlife by hunting, ie, they were game reserves where hunting was prohibited. Many of these still exist today, but have been integrated into the new, larger, protected areas.

Animal life is protected, except during a brief annual hunting season. Alpine tourists may observe marmots, which live in the high meadows, and chamois. Large herds of the round ibex, which had died out in the Swiss Alps and has since been reintroduced, populate several areas, especially in the Bernina region of Graubünden (canton) and in the Saastal of Valais.
